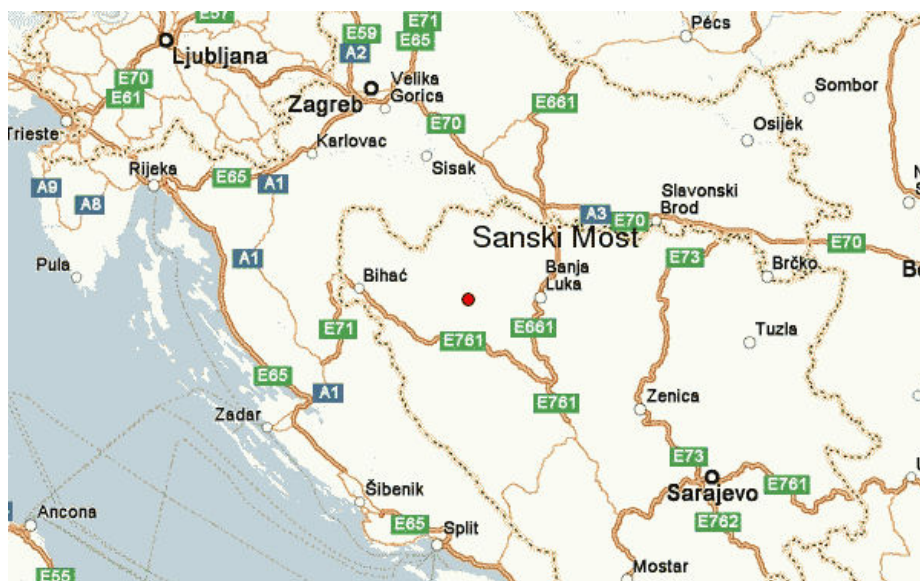

The geographical position of the Sanski Most Municipality is very favorable in regards to traffic. It is situated on the road that links Banjaluka and Prijedor with Ključ and Drvar. It is also well connected with the whole Una-Sana Canton through which run the main corridors: Western Europe - Mediterranean - Near East.

The basis of the development are the natural resources: forests, water and land. Climate conditions are favorable for livestock, crop husbandry, vegetable growing, fruit growing and apiculture.

The River Sana with its confluents: Sanica, Dabar, Bliha, Zdena, Kozica, Kijevusa, Sasina and Majdanusa represents important water resources, adequate for construction of mini HPP which may be the basis of the municipality development. Thermo and thermo-mineral water (Ilidza Spa), caves (Dabarska and Hrustovacka), Bliha Waterfall are adequate for tourism development. Sanski Most has one industrial zone - "Sejkovaca" which offers parcels for sale per reasonable price. Every year the municipality invests for the development and reconstruction of the industrial zone and so this year also the municipality will allocate a significant amount of funds for construction in order to encourage investment and employment.

The Local government is dedicated to creating a favorable business environment and it shows through cooperation with existing entrepreneurs.

The Economic Council of the Sanski Most Municipality is a proof of successful cooperation between the private and public sectors to the common ideas and projects contributing Sanski Most to be strong and developed municipality.
